MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT AND THE SCHOLARSHIP CHAIR



For students across suburban Eastern Jackson, Cass, and Lafayette Counties, this year's THCF scholarship awards brought a surge of excitement and possibility. With a record-breaking 2,136 applications received, the competition was fierce. But for the 312 unique students who were awarded scholarships from 159 named scholarships, the rewards were well worth the effort.

In total, Truman Heartland Community Foundation's scholarship program will provide an impressive \$738,050 in financial support for students pursuing higher education for 2023-2024. And the year-over-year increases were equally impressive. Comparing 2022's program totals at the time of program printing to this year's, the number of applications received jumped by an incredible 53%, while the total awards increased by 14.4%. The number of unique students receiving awards increased by 16%, and named scholarships saw a 17% boost. And to meet the increased need, the number of reviewers increased, jumping up by 10.4%. We will continue to issue scholarships throughout the year based on the criteria set forth in partnership with our scholarship donors, so expect to see even higher numbers to be reported in the 2023 annual report.

There is absolutely no way the Foundation could have waded through the vast number of applications without the help of our dedicated scholarship committee volunteers who give up personal time on evenings and weekends to read, review, and score applications. A special thank you to THCF's Scholarship Committee, which adjudicated more than 450 applications this year for 22 different scholarship funds. Their work resulted in \$247,850 in awards, reflected in the pages that follow.

We would also like to express our gratitude to our education foundation partners, Fort Osage Education Foundation, Grain Valley Education Foundation, Lafayette County C-1 Educational Foundation, Oak Grove Education Foundation, and Raytown Education Foundation, for collaborating with THCF on their scholarship programs. Together, we are changing the lives of students throughout the region.

This year's numbers tell a story of a community that is dedicated to helping its students succeed. With more applications, more awards, and more students receiving scholarships, Truman Heartland Community Foundation's scholarship program is clearly making a difference in the lives of students across the region. And as the Foundation continues to grow and expand its reach, there is no doubt that even more students will benefit from the generosity and support of our generous fundholders.

For those who received scholarships this year, the awards represent more than just financial assistance. They represent a vote of confidence in their abilities and potential, and a promise of support as they pursue their dreams. And for the Truman Heartland Community Foundation scholarship fundholders, these awards represent a commitment to a brighter future for all.


